

## **BUTTERFIELD TOWNSHIP GUIDELINE RESOLUTION FOR POVERTY EXEMPTION**

**WHEREAS**, the adoption of guidelines for poverty exemptions is required of the Butterfield Township Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the principal residence of persons, who the Board of Review determines by reason of poverty to be unable to contribute to the public charge, is eligible for exemption in whole or in part from taxation under Public Act 390 of 1994 (MCL 211.7u); and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to PA 390 of 1994, the Township of Butterfield, Missaukee County adopts the following guidelines for the Board of Review to implement. The guidelines shall include but not be limited to the specific income and asset levels of the claimant; and

**WHEREAS**, a specific policy for granting the poverty exemption has been adopted and approved by resolution on November 09, 2020 by the Butterfield Township Board. A copy of this policy shall be attached hereto and adopted with the 2021 Federal Poverty Income Guidelines

The following are the federal poverty income guidelines which are updated annually by the United States Department of Health and Human Services. The annual allowable income includes income for all persons residing in the principal residence.

### **2021 Federal Poverty Guidelines:**
